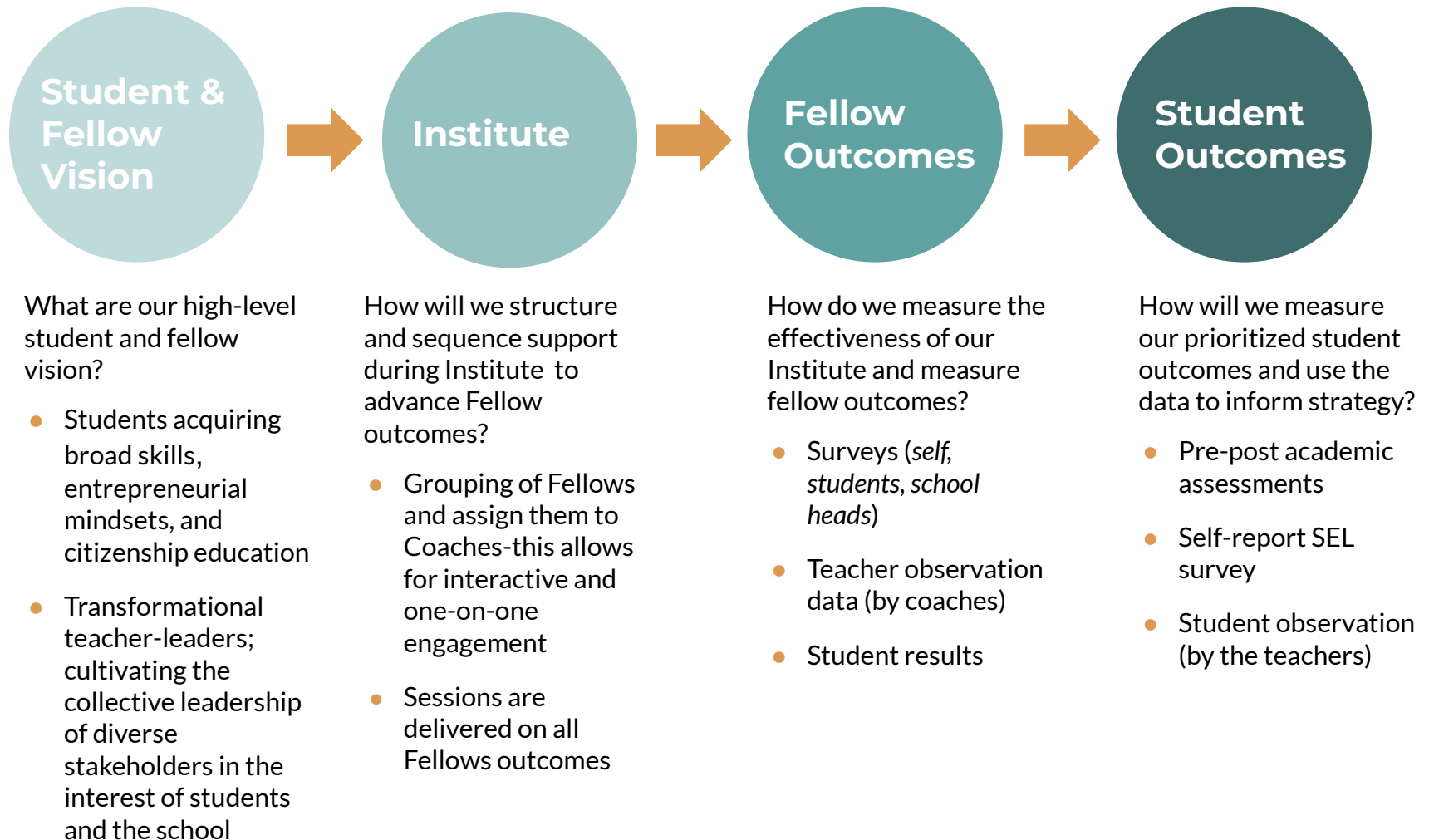

- Citizenship

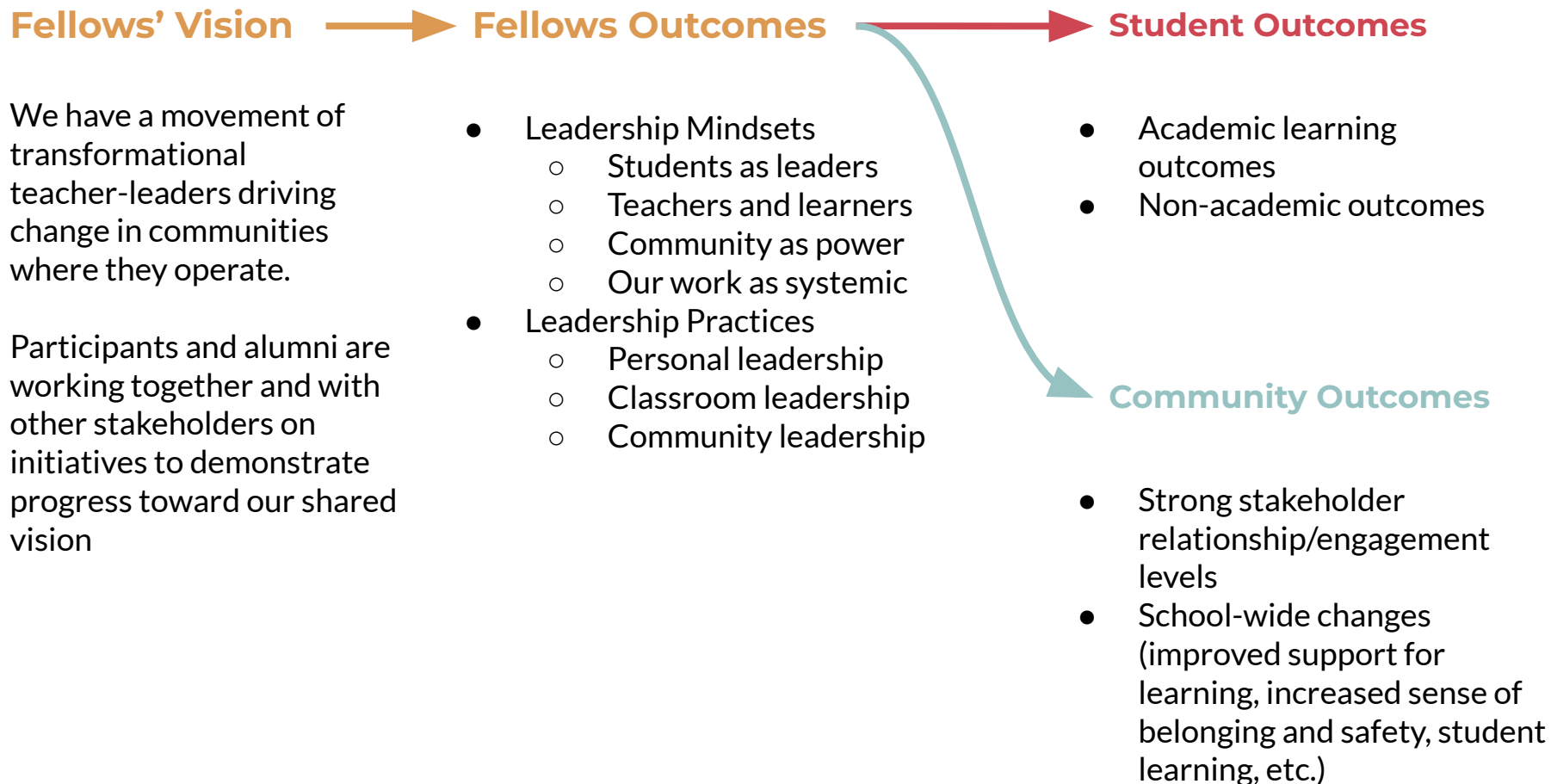
Academic outcomes

- Basic science, Tech., Arts, etc.

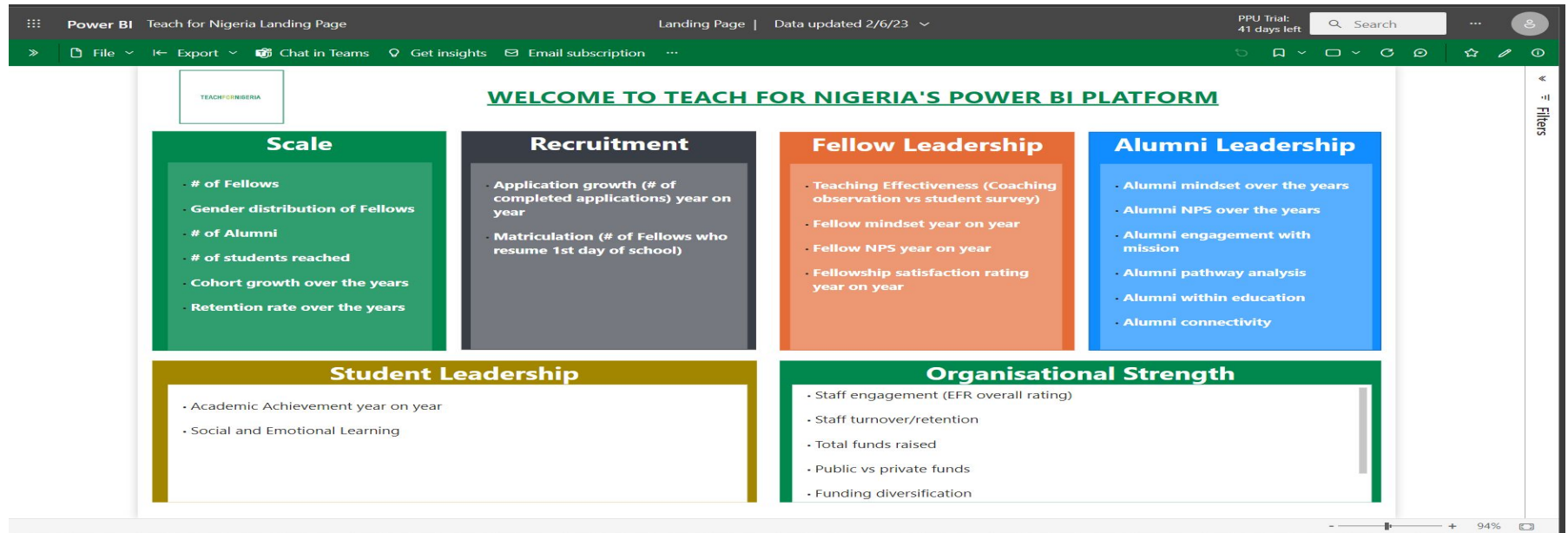
Non-academic outcomes

Curriculum

Our student and teacher vision forms the core of our curriculum

We review our curriculum based on our annual report

Teachers and students feedback form a huge part of the curriculum review process

Delivery
